Things to bring to the exam

- Several sharpened No. 2 pencils with erasers, for all responses on multiple choice answer sheet.
- Pens with black or blue ink for completing areas on the exam booklet and for free response questions.
- A watch that does not have internet access, does not beep, and does not have an alarm.
- A calculator if you're taking AP Calculus, Chemistry, Physics, or the Statistics exam. Visit www.collegeboard.com/apstudents to learn more about the calculator policy for each of these exams, and for a list of authorized calculators. You can also talk to your AP teachers.
- Picture ID (School ID, California ID, or Drivers License)
- Your AP student pack which will be distributed to you during the first AP exam you take.
- A light sweater or jacket in case the room temperature is below your comfort level. The gym can get chilly.

You should NOT bring the following to the exam. We do not want to spend time collecting electronic devices and items below before the exam. If found in possession, you will be dismissed.

- No purses or backpacks.
- Electronic equipment (cell phone, laptop, tablet computer, iWatch, etc.), portable listening devices or recording devices (MP3 player, iPod, etc.), cameras or other photographic equipment, devices that can access the internet, and any other electronic or communication devices.
- Books, compasses, protractors, electronic pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, notes, or color pencils.
- Rulers and straightedges (except as noted above).
- Scratch paper (notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets).
- Food or drink to consume **during** the test. Clothing with subject-related information is not allowed.

Important Testing day reminder

- Bring a #2 pencil, pen, and picture ID.
- No purse or backpacks.
- You are required to arrive by **7:30 a.m. for your morning exam and by 11:45 a.m. for the afternoon exam.**
- Get a good night's rest before your test, and eat a nutritious breakfast. Bring a light sweater.
- If you are taking an afternoon exam bring a bag lunch from home since the cafeteria will not be open.
- **If you would like to be on campus only for testing on the day you take AP exams, you need to bring a note from your parent excusing you to do so. Otherwise, you are required to attend your classes during the time you are not testing.**
- Do not ask to leave early if you finish before the end of the test, as your request will be denied. **If you play a sport or have a job, it will be your responsibility to inform your coach or employer of your AP obligation and arrangements should be made accordingly.**
